RESOLUTION

GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR TO SIGN THE DEED OF USUFRUCT TO BE EXECUTED BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIMAMAYLAN AND THE MARINE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMAND, THROUGH MARINE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ENFORCEMENT AND RESPONSE GROUP SOUTHERN VISAYAS, RELATIVE TO THE 555 SQUARE METER PORTION OF LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF MARINE POLLUTION (MARPOL) CENTER

WHEREAS, the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) is mandated under Section 3(o) and Section 23 of Republic Act No. 9993 to develop oil spill response, containment, and recovery capabilities against pollution and establish its strategic presence;

WHEREAS, the Marine Environmental Protection Enforcement and Response Group Southern Visayas of the Philippine Coast Guard is in need of the parcel of land for the construction of its Marine Pollution (MARPOL) Center;

WHEREAS, the City of Himamaylan recognizes the urgent need to establish a Marine Pollution Control Center to address the growing environmental challenges affecting its coastal areas and offers a Five Hundred Fifty Five (555) square meters portion of land situated at Barangay Talaban, Himamaylan City, for the aforesaid purpose;

WHEREAS, the term of the usufruct shall be for Twenty-Five (25) years, renewable at the discretion of the City of Himamaylan, being the lawful and registered owner of the parcel of land;

WHEREAS, the execution of a Deed of Usufruct will formalize the terms and conditions stipulated therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Samuel R. Belarga, seconded unanimously by all Members present, it is;

RESOLVED, to grant authority to the City Mayor to sign the Deed of Usufruct to be executed by and between the City of Himamaylan and the Marine Environmental Protection Command, through Marine Environmental Protection Enforcement and Response Group Southern Visayas, relative to the 555 square meter portion of land for the construction of Marine Pollution (MARPOL) Center

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Resolution No. 2024-236, dated December 18, 2024, entitled "granting authority to the City Mayor to sign the Deed of Usufruct to be executed by and between the City of Himamaylan and the Marine Environmental Protection Command, through Marine Environmental Protection Enforcement and Response Group Southern Visayas, relative to the 550 square meter portion of land for the construction of Marine Pollution (MARPOL) Center" is hereby cancelled.
